

**RESOLUTION NO. 162-2021, ESTABLISHING AN ANNUAL  
RECOGNITION OF A HEALTHCARE HERO FROM EACH  
LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 410-2020 designated the month of June as “Healthcare Heroes Month” to acknowledge the inspiring and selfless contributions of the County’s frontline healthcare workers; and

**WHEREAS**, there are frontline healthcare workers throughout the County who should be recognized personally for their service to our community; and

**WHEREAS**, all legislators in Suffolk County should designate a healthcare hero from his or her legislative district to honor during the newly established Healthcare Heroes Month each June; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that, beginning in 2021 and continuing every year thereafter, each member of the County Legislature shall designate a “Healthcare Hero” representing his or her respective legislative district as an individual to be publicly recognized through a legislative pronouncement at the first June general meeting of the Legislature of each year for their contributions serving the healthcare needs of their community; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW insofar as these actions constitute routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
