## RESOLUTION NO. 443-2022, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH SUFFOLK COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY BODY CAMERA SYSTEM (CP 3532)

**WHEREAS**, the Police Commissioner has requested funds to purchase body cameras along with ancillary items to include hardware, software and initial training; and

**WHEREAS**, body worn cameras would enhance accountability from personnel and increase public trust; and

**WHEREAS**, body worn cameras would increase transparency, case resolution and evidentiary corroboration while also providing and effective training tool for police recruits as well as veteran officers; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2022 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said purchase under CP 3532; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 1027-2020, established the use of a new priority capital ranking system, effective January 1, 2021, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project and as required, an updated capital project ranking form was completed for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature has authorized the issuance of \$8,000,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds pending adoption of bond resolution; now, therefore be it
