**RESOLUTION NO. 575-2023, REALLOCATING \$1,025,000 IN
OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDING AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDING SELECTION COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Resolution No. 15-2023 included the award of capital funding to the Town of Babylon for a new substance use disorder clinic to expand services to address treatment and recovery of individuals impacted by substance use disorders; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Babylon has requested re-allocation of \$350,000 of Town of Babylon program funds to support the increased costs of construction its opioid capital project; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Resolution No. 15-2023 included the award of \$675,000 to Project Safety Net NY for Mobile Outreach Resource Expansion to address substance use treatment and recovery; and

WHEREAS Project Safety Net NY for Mobile Outreach Resource Expansion address substance use treatment and recovery is no longer taking on new business; and

WHEREAS, Family and Children's Association has agreed to assume the operation of Project Safety Net NY opioid award program in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Resolution No. 609-2022 established the Opioid Settlement Funding Selection Committee to manage the important task of allocating opioid litigation settlement funding received by the County of Suffolk; and

WHEREAS, the Opioid Settlement Funding Selection Committee has approved the re-allocation of funds to the Town of Babylon and Project Safety Net NY; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to re-appropriate \$1,025,000 within the Opioid Abatement, Recovery and Support Fund to the contract agencies listed below as follows:

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller is hereby directed and empowered to appropriate the above monies to the respective agencies and to allow any unspent monies to be rolled over to the following fiscal year in accordance to the executed contract for each agency; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), N.Y. Environmental Conservation Law Article 8 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5 (26) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS ("NYCRR") in that the action constitutes routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and adoption of regulations, policies, procedures and local legislative decisions in connection with any action on this list. The Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
